

Cherry Explosion Hydrangea



Hydrangea macrophylla 'McKay'

- **Use:** This Hydrangea EXPLODES with long lasting color and makes a bold statement in any garden! With incredibly large, bright cherry red florets, this lacecap variety is very unique and different from other Hydrangeas on the market. Super hardy to zone 4 with a longer bloom window, this variety performs well in a wide range of conditions.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun is best or at least protection from hot afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN! When grown in acid soils, the flower color is lavender.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 3' feet high; equal width in only 4 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large heart shaped leaves. The fall color of the foliage is burgundy when the cool weather comes on long and slow.
- **Flower:** Cherry red florets arranged in a circle with a profusion of tiny star like light pink flowers in the center of this gorgeous bloom.
