Hydrangea macrophylla 'Dear Dolores'

- **Use:** Blooms in spring and reblooms summer to fall. Blue blooms occur in acidic soils. Pink blooms occur in alkaline soils. Fast growing deciduous shrub, bright green foliage, mounding growth habit. Excellent choice for shady border planting.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun is best. DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN! (In full sun they wilt constantly in our hot summer heat and leaf burn) Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. Depending on soil pH, you can have vivid rose-pink or purple-blue hydrangea flower heads.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 5 feet high; 5' width in only 4 years.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large leaves offer a lush backdrop for the showy blossoms AND TURN BURGUNDY RED IN FALL.
- **Flower:** Large blue or pink flowers rebloom spring to fall
