

Endless Summer Hydrangea



A must have for every garden!

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Endless Summer'

- **Use:** The rocketing popularity of 'Endless Summer' results from the fact that, unlike most hydrangeas, this one has the ability to bloom as far north as Minnesota (maybe much further). In the south, where hydrangeas rarely bloom more than once per summer, 'Endless Summer' will often produce a full set of blooms twice each summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN!**
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 4 feet high; equal width in only 4 years.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** can bloom for more than six months in warm areas, especially if deadheaded regularly, and the flower heads—blue on acid soils, pink on alkaline—are up to 9in across.
