Hydrangea macrophylla 'Firefly

- <u>Use</u>: Firefly is a unique semi-double reblooming mophead with amazing bicolored flowers of red with a cream eye. These blooms almost appear painted and flower all summer long.
- Exposure/Soil: Partial (60-70% of the day) sun is best. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN! in the South or you will get leaf burn in August and it will wilt on hot days.
- **Growth**: Fast-growing to 4feet high; equal width in only 4 years.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 6-11; Shrub
- Foliage: Deciduous. Large heart shaped leaves.
- <u>Flower:</u> Dark pink and buttermilk-colored individual florettes mature to bright pink-edged, cream-centered flowers that look as if they have been painted. Semi-double "mophead" hydrangea will provide lots of flowers all Summer long. Blooms spring to fall.
