

Star Gazer Hydrangea



**A must have for every garden!
Blooms on old and new growth for
an extended season of blooms!**

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Star Gazer' ('Kompeito')

- **Use:** Gorgeous lacecap clusters of small, double pink or blue blooms pop against the lush, dark green foliage. In alkaline soils, the stars are pink; in acidic, they're blue. Blooms on old wood in the spring and new wood from summer to fall.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun/ light afternoon shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN in the South!**
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 3-4' H x 3-5' W
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Handsome, green foliage.
- **Flower:** Continuous blooms forming on old and new wood along with mildew tolerance, set this lacecap apart from the other hydrangeas in this collection. You will never get tired of the perfect, double blooms that are white with star pink or star blue centers.
