

# Hydrangea 'Wedding Gown'



**A must have for every garden! Blooms on old and new growth for an extended season of blooms!**

## *Hydrangea macrophylla* 'Wedding Gown' ('Dancing Snow')

- **Use:** Each fully double, white flower head of this Lacecap Hydrangea is like a mini bridal bouquet, with an outer ring of large, double flowers surrounding a center packed with smaller, double ones. Flowering begins earlier than that of most varieties of *Hydrangea macrophylla* and continues on new growth into fall if spent blooms are removed regularly.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun/ light shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN!**
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 3 to 4 feet high; equal width in only 3 –4 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Handsome foliage on boldly branched, mounded form.
- **Flower:** Likened to a small bridal bouquet, large, double white blooms start out as mopheads and open as lacecaps.
