

# Bobo Hydrangea



A new dwarf hydrangea that is sure to turn heads! Reaching to just three feet tall, it will be engulfed by enormous creamy white flowers in summer, providing a nonstop show until frost. An undeniable asset to any garden, particularly where space is limited.



## *Hydrangea paniculata* 'Bobo' 'Ilvobo'

- **Use:** From the same hybridizer as the award-winning Pinky Winky®, Bobo® was introduced in Belgium where its compact size was celebrated as a center of interest tucked in smaller garden borders and in containers on terraces. Gold medal winner for its innovative size and habit. Because Paniculata Hydrangeas bloom on new growth, they typically flower normally even if the twigs have been killed back by frost.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in a sunny, well-drained spot; some early afternoon shade is beneficial in hot southern regions. Prune in late winter or early spring. Soil pH does not affect flower color.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 3 feet high; equal width in only 3 –4 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Coarsely toothed, glossy, dark-green leaves.
- **Flower:** Plants are covered midsummer to fall with large blooms held on strong stems. Blossoms are held upright on strong stems, and continue to grow and lengthen as they bloom. In fall, flowers may turn a pinkish hue.
