

Hydrangea 'Moon Dance'



We have found that as *Hydrangea paniculata* ages leaves become coarse and the deer leave it alone. We protected young foliage with “Liquid Fence”, and now have had no deer browsing in 5 years and herds of deer. A must have for every garden! Blooms on old and new growth for an extended season of blooms!

Hydrangea paniculata 'Moon Dance'

- **Use:** Dazzling white conical panicles in summer distinguish this graceful hydrangea. Sturdy stems support the large blooms without drooping. It is stunning as a cut flower or in the garden, and its compact habit ensures it's suitable either as an accent or mass planting.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun/ light shade. Can tolerate full sun once established, but will see leaf burn in August/ September. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 6-8' tall x 4-5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Handsome, green foliage.
- **Flower:** Dazzling white conical panicles in summer distinguish this graceful hydrangea. Sturdy stems support the large blooms without drooping. Great as a cutflower if cut in the morning and stems are treated with “Alum” (found in spice aisle for pickling). – Florist tip.
