

Hydrangea 'Fuji Waterfalls'



A must have for every garden!

Hydrangea serrata 'Fuji Waterfalls'

- **Use:** An unusual double-flowered Lacecap Hydrangea, for both the central sterile flowers and the pure white outer flowers are double. But what's special is that the outer flowers are carried on unusually long slender stems so they dance delightfully around the edge of the flower head.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Partial sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Keep water off leaves. **DO NOT PLANT IN FULL SUN!**
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to 3 to 4 feet high; equal width in only 3 – 4 years.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Handsome foliage on boldly branched, mounded form.
- **Flower:** The white lacecap blooms have double sepals that cascade over deep, dark tapered leaves giving a wonderful waterfall effect.
