

Schillings/ Dwarf Yaupon Holly



Best known for use as planting under windows up near the home.

Ilex vomitoria 'Nana'

- **Use:** It makes an excellent evergreen foundation planting or hedge, or as an evergreen background for bulbs and flowering perennials.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun to part shade. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Water if it hasn't rained in 2 weeks.
- **Growth:** This is a low growing, spreading variety of Holly with a dwarf mounding habit spreading up to 5' width, but only reaching a maximum of 3' in height.
- **Hardiness:** 6-8, shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Purple tinge on new growth turns a lustrous dark green.
- **Flower:** Not known for flowers. Small, black berries not very visible.
