Ilex x Acadiana[™] PP#14418

- **Use:** This Red Holly[™] is the tightest branching habit of the group. With deep red new growth and a heavy berry set this plant will make either a beautiful garden accent or a dense hedge row. Untrimmed or lightly -trimmed trees usually carry the most berries. Branches can be cut for your home in winter, or to create Christmas wreaths with a unique look.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun-part shade. Well-drained soil, not soggy. Water the 1st two years for best growth during drought. For fastest growth use slow release fertilizer two times a year!
- **Growth:** Strong growth 14 feet tall and 8 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The new growth has a bronze to red coloration that matures to a deep glossy green. The foliage is heavily serrated making the plant an excellent choice for an impenetrable privacy screen
- **Flower:** The addition of brilliant, red berries in autumn adds to the display, a stand-out in any setting. The berries persist into the winter, a popular draw for your feathered friends, who adore Holly for its winter treat and reliable shelter. Other wild creatures likewise enjoy Holly, so it's an overall boon for your natural surroundings.
