

Savannah Holly



Ilex x attenuate 'Savannah'

Loved for it's ability to be trained as a small tree, or pyramidal shaped accent shrub.

- **Use:** Beloved for it's beautiful tree shape and for the clusters of berries in the winter! Has whitish bark with light green leaves with very small spines. Savannah Holly tolerates limy soils well and makes a great for tall screens.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun-part shade. Well-drained soil, not soggy. Water the 1st two years for best growth. If it doesn't rain for 7-10 days, then water. For fastest growth use slow release fertilizer two times a year!
- **Growth:** Strong growth 20 feet tall and 15 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Dark evergreen foliage.
- **Flower:** Vivid red fruit; single or clusters of 2 to 3 .
