Ilex x latifolia

- **Use:** We love this pyramid shaped holly for it's winter interest. Shiny green leaves and red berries make a lovely scene in the winter and stay green year round.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Forms a small tree that grows 15' to 25' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone: 6-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Southern magnolia shaped leaf with coarsely serrated margins. Black stipules form prominent dots at the base of the petiole. These hollies make fantastic Christmas foliage.
- **Flower:** Large red fruit in fist shaped clusters that are extremely showy. Dioecious (Has male and female flowers on same plant)
