

# Everblooming Fragrant Banana Shrub



**FRAGRANT!** It can be used as a large specimen shrub, background shrub, hedge, screen, espalier, or is easily trained into a small single or multi-trunked tree.

## *Michelia figo 'Hagiwara'*

- **Use:** A repeat flowering Banana Magnolia with a more intense sweet banana fragrance! Produces sweetly fragrant cupped soft yellow flowers for much of summer on this large evergreen shrub to small tree.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Morning sun/afternoon part shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Prefers well drained soils so please be sure to amend the red clay. Easy to grow and enjoy in most well-drained acidic soils.
- **Growth:** Growth generally slows as they get larger and closer to their mature size of about 10' high but they may reach 20' with age.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7A-10; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen; Medium sized, medium green leaves.
- **Flower:** Spring– summer flowers are creamy yellow edged in maroon and fragrant like bananas.
