Nandina domestica 'Seika'

- **Use**: This new and distinctive nandina is an upright, compact, dense grower with brilliant red new foliage, and richer color than ordinary nandinas.
- **Exposure/Soil**: Plant in full sun to partial sun. Will tolerate some shade, but will be less vibrant in chartreuse color. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves for best results. Drought tolerant once established.
- **Growth**: Dwarf habit 3 to 4 ft. tall and wide.
- **Hardiness**: Zone 6-10; Shrub
- **Foliage**: Evergreen. Brilliant red, new foliage.
- **Flower**: Tiny white flowers in spring, but not noticeable.
