

Mountain Snow Japanese Pieris



Good for use in light shade woodland gardens. Fragrant!



Pieris japonica 'Mountain Snow'

- **Use:** Also known as Lily of the Valley Shrub. Fragrant! Compact rounded evergreen broadleaf shrub. Grows well in containers. Produces greenish berries in summer. Deer resistant. Compact habit with white flowers in spring. More sun tolerant than other Pieris.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Morning sun / afternoon shade. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Will tolerate more sun and drought after a few years of growth and establishment.
- **Growth:** Moderate, upright grower to 4 to 6 ft. tall, 4 to 6 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Fire-red new growth turns dark green when mature.
- **Flower:** Fragrant urn-shaped white flowers in 3-5" pendulous panicles April-May.
