Rhaphiolepis indica 'Sodark'

- **Use:** Part of Calisto's appeal comes from its functionality, size, and ease of care, but the strikingly beautiful blooms and foliage are its real stars! The brilliant pink flowers of Calisto are richer than many blooms within the species. New introduction in 2007.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 3 ft tall and 4 ft. wide.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, shrub
- **Foliage:** The foliage is a very deep green and the leaves have a curled effect.
- **Flower:** The spring-summer blooms of this variety are a deeper pink than any other we have seen. Purplish-black fruit in fall. Purplish-black fruit in fall.
