

White Indian Hawthorne



Rhaphiolepis 'Snow White'

- **Use:** A somewhat spreading dwarf shrub and will put on a show in early spring through summer with clusters of white flowers. Snow White Hawthorn has vigorous growth with good branching to create a more uniform shrub than other Hawthorn cultivars.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Fairly drought tolerant. They do not like sprinklers, if you must use a sprinkler do so only in the morning. They prefer dry leaves.
- **Growth:** Compact type that grows 2-3' tall and wide. May easily be kept shorter.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-10, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen New growth is red, maturing into a dark green color. Good leaf spot resistance.
- **Flower:** Small flowers are fragrant. White flowers in early spring through summer.
