

Redbird Indian Hawthorne



Excellent as a small hedge or foundation planting

***Rhaphiolepis indica* 'Redbird'**

- **Use:** Features burgundy-red new growth followed by white flowers that flush pink in spring. Excellent as a small hedge or foundation planting.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6' tall and wide. May easily be kept shorter.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9, Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen New growth is red, maturing into a dark green color.
- **Flower:** Small, white, fragrant flowers bloom in early spring.
