## *Rhododendron 'Grace'*

- **Use:** The exciting new Southgate™ Rhododendrons are heat tolerant and thrive in the Deep South while performing equally well in traditional Rhododendron areas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun to shade. As with other azaleas, the partial shade of tall trees overhead is the ideal. It will adapt to full-sun sites, though. You just need to water it during times when it isn't raining enough. Grows best in moist, well-drained, organic soils with a pH range from 4.5 to 6.0. "Well-drained" is the key. Planting it in places that don't drain well is a sure death sentence.
- **Growth:** Habit is upright and bushy. Grows 4-5' tall and 4'-5' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 6-9 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. Leaves are lance shaped, medium sized and light green.
- **Flower:** Deep pink buds open to white in spring.
