- **Use:** The colorful hues vary with different climates. Maybe it's chocolate, maybe it's smoky or brick or russet. You'll be amazed by the beauty and interest that this Floribunda will create in your garden. Easy to grow.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Best grown in medium moisture, slightly acidic, well-drained garden loams in full sun. Tolerates some light shade, but best flowering and disease resistance generally occur in full sun. Water deeply and regularly (mornings are best). Avoid overhead watering. Good air circulation promotes vigorous and healthy growth and helps control foliar diseases. Summer mulch helps retain moisture, keeps roots cool and discourages weeds. Remove spent flowers to encourage rebloom.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-5' tall and 4' tall.
- **Hardiness:** 5-10 Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Glossy dark green compound leaves have 3-7 oval leaflets.
- **Flower:** Double flowers appear in clusters of 2-5 per stem over a May to frost bloom period. Flowers have a moderate tea fragrance.
