

# Sunshine Daydream Rose



Sunshine Daydream is an 2012 AARS (All-American Rose Selections®) winner. This means it out-performed all the other roses entered and trialed in 20 different gardens across the country under no-spray conditions for a period of two years.

## *Rosa 'Sunshine Daydream'*

- **Use:** A full flowered, butter-yellow colored garden rose. It has the vigor, form and foliage you would expect from a traditional garden rose, but it has the added benefit and convenience of being disease resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. During the winter they prefer well-drained soils. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 5-6' tall and 4' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-9; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. It is expected to hold onto its foliage long into the season unlike old hybrid tea roses which are mostly leafless sticks by July or August.
- **Flower:** Each flowering stem bears up to eight 3½-inch blooms of soft butter-yellow that matures to a rich shade of cream over time. Superb disease resistance keeps the glossy dark green foliage healthy. Petals 30-35, Bloom 3 1/2"
