

Candy Corn Spirea



Spirea japonica 'Double Play Candy Corn'

- **Use:** Meet the newest and most colorful Proven Winners spirea, Double Play® Candy Corn™. The show starts in earliest spring, when the new growth emerges bright candy apple red. As it matures, it turns pineapple yellow, and the new growth continues to emerge bright orange all season. Top it off with dark purple flowers in late spring/early summer, and you've got a display you really have to see to believe. Be sure to click the image tab below to see just how showy this low-maintenance spiraea is!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Drought tolerant once established
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 18-24” tall and wide. It naturally takes on a nice, rounded habit without pruning. If you wish, you can give it a trim after the flowers fade, which will encourage even more colorful new growth.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4 –8; Shrub
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Bright candy apple red foliage emerges in spring and matures to a bold yellow, with a continuous topping of blazing orange all season long.
- **Flower:** It delivers an additional burst of color with its vibrant, red-violet blooms.
