

Juliet Cleyera japonica



This easy care, upright cleyera is disease and

pest resistant and heat tolerant. It provides year round interest with maroon new growth turning to glossy green and creamy white variegated foliage.

Ternstroemia gymnanthera 'Juliet'

- **Use:** Consider growing these in garden planters or containers for added flexibility on locations limited on space or sunlight. Space these slightly closer together to create a hedge, perfect for borders, privacy and wind protection. Stays short and perfect as a border plant, which are perfect placed along the edge of a garden bed or path. Fantastic as a mass planting, which is a method of filling in a landscape area with flower groupings of one or more kinds of plants. **Exposure/Soil:** *Full to partial sun*. Prefers well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water when top 3 in of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower to 8 to 10 ft. tall and 5 to 6 ft wide. Easily kept shorter however with pruning.
- **Hardiness:** *Zone 7-10*; Shrub or Houseplant. We recommend you plant them on a protected wall away from extreme winter cold to prevent leaf burn in winter. We have had ours for 5 years, however, with no problems!
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Attractive, variegated, glossy foliage with an upright habit. New growth is maroon with a creamy white variegation.
- **Flowers:** Not known for flowers. There may be fragrant, small, creamy-white flowers appear in loose clusters at the ends of the branches or from the joint between the leaves and the stems in late spring or early summer. Flowers may be followed by fruit.
