

Kagiri Nishiki Japanese Maple



Graceful and beautiful tree for the garden!

Acer palmatum 'Roseo Marginatum' / 'Kagiri nishiki'

- **Use:** A large stately colour accent tree with incredible green, white and pink-variegated foliage, often mottled on the same leaf, must be seen to be believed.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers lightly sun dappled part shade. Avoid hot and dry sites. Leaves may scorch in full sun in hot southern summers if in too much sun. Plant in a location protected from strong winds. Prune out non-variegated foliage.
- **Growth:** Slowly reaches 8 ft. tall, 4 ft. wide in 10 years; may reach 15 ft. with age. A fine, slow growing, small, vase-shaped tree for courtyards and Asian-themed gardens. An ideal size for a container specimen
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8, medium sized tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small leaves with margins of pink and white. Pink tones on the foliage become more pronounced in fall.
- **Flower:** Inconspicuous. Clusters of red to purplish inflorescences in late May and early June are often hidden by the foliage.
