

Green Bamboo Japanese Maple



This Japanese maple tree is a great addition to your garden and brings an exotic feel.

Acer palmatum l. 'Scolopendrifolium'

- **Use:** Scolopendrifolium is a very nice deep green linearilobum that in full sun bronzes with beautiful shades of red. Vigorous and hardy, this plant will reach 10 feet in 10 years. Fantastic blazing fall colors of orange and red!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers morning sun and afternoon shade in the South. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Will not tolerate soggy or extremely dry soil.
- **Growth:** Height at 10 years of 8-10' tall ; Mature at 20-22' tall by 20' wide. While the overall growth tends to be slow and bushy sometimes new limbs can grow three or 4 feet in just a few weeks. These limbs are generally unattractive and should be pruned.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8, medium sized tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The light green leaves are very thin and long and mimic that of bamboo. Emerges in the spring with a very nice light green and changes in the fall to a fantastic red.
- **Flower:** Clusters of red to purplish inflorescences in late May and early June are often hidden by the foliage.
