***Cornus kousa* 'Greensleeves'**

- **Use:** Cappello and Shadow, in their book, Dogwoods, call it one of the very best kousa varieties. Strong growth makes it a great garden plant, and its handsome foliage and abundant flowers give it universal appeal. Anthracnose resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Grows 15-20' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Deep green waxy foliage that turns to robust autumn shades of red and purple.
- **Flower:** Flowers suffused with a hint of green on cream. Heavy fruit set.
