

# Black Diamond Pure White Crape Myrtle



Crape Myrtles look particularly nice when lining driveways or fences, and can also be planted in a container on your deck or patio as long as the container is at least 12 in. diameter.



## *Lagerstroemia indica* 'Black Diamond Pure White'

- **Use:** The Black Diamond Crape These crape myrtles are drought tolerant, mildew resistant, and low-maintenance. p
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves so use drip instead of sprinkler irrigation.
- **Growth:** This variety has been described as having an intermediate growth habit, reaching 10 ft. to 12 ft. tall, a spread of 4 ft. to 5 ft., and can be used as a specimen or in mass plantings.
- **Hardiness:** Zones 6-9
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Mildew resistant dark leaves.
- **Flowers:** A vibrant bright white which offset the intense hues of the dark leaves. The bright blooms of the Black Diamond reach their productivity peak during the summer and fall months.
