- <u>Use:</u> This Crapemyrtle released by the U. S. National Arboretum has watermelon red hot blooms with contrasting, intense black leaves. Blooms from summer through fall. Excellent as an accent plant.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- Growth: Grows 10-12' tall and 8'wide.
- *Hardiness: Zone 6-9*; Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree.
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. The leaves turn a vibrant orange-red in the fall.
- <u>Flowers</u>: The deep crimson red blossoms start in June, and bloom through to September.
