Lagerstroemia 'Ebony Ivory'

- **Use:** This Crape Myrtle released by the U. S. National Arboretum has striking white blooms with contrasting, intense black leaves. Blooms from summer through fall. Excellent as an accent plant. They were selected for disease resistance, dark non-fading foliage, clear brightly colored flowers, and various growth habits.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows 10 to 12 feet tall and 8 feet wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The leaves turn a vibrant orange-red in the fall.
- **Flowers:** Produces large clusters of large, pure white flowers with yellow eyes that simply glow against the dark purple, nearly black foliage.
