- **Use:** Miss Francis Crape Myrtle is a new breakthrough in color, producing dense clusters of flowers in the perfect lipstick red. The foliage is lustrous green, and remains healthy all summer, as this plant has been bred to resist disease.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** At maturity, it can reach a height of 15 feet plus. Crepe Myrtles will easily grow 3-5 feet a year – Often double in size during spring growth. Round spreading growth habit.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Small Tree .
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small, glossy, dark green foliage emerges maroon; bronze-red fall color. The mature bark is a greyed-orange color.
- **Flowers:** A new deep red flowered crape myrtle. It produces lustrous green leaves with dark red flowers for an extended flowering season from late June into August.
