

Muskogee Crape Myrtle



Lagerstroemia indica 'Muskogee'

- **Use:** It grows well in limited soil spaces in urban areas such as along boulevards, in parking lots, and in small pavement cutouts if provided with some irrigation until well established. Very drought tolerant. Highly resistant to powdery mildew.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full/part sun; well-draining soil and appreciates slow release fertilizer. Water regularly. They tolerate clay and alkaline soil well. Prefers not to have water on the leaves.
- **Growth:** Grows 10' or more taller. Shape into a tree but cutting out weak shoots.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9; Multi-stemmed shrub or small tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Fall colors are red and orange.
- **Flowers:** A USNA selection with light lavender-pink flowers.

Heat loving small tree with lots of color!
