Magnolia grandiflora 'Kay Parris'

- **Use:** It produces creamy white fragrant flowers in May that are bigger than 'Little Gem'. It differentiates itself from other varieties by its wavy edge to its leaf and its bright pink new growth. Its extremely glossy, bright green leaves with deep orange-brown fuzzy undersides and long flowering season make this a standout. Fast, upright growth.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Thrives in any light from full sun to shade, and tolerates just about any well-drained garden soil. Enjoy this one-of-a-kind beauty!
- **Growth:** Fast growing to 15-35 ft. tall by 7-12 ft. wide in 10 years.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-10; Tree.
- **Foliage:** Evergreen. The leaves of this evergreen shrub or small tree are rusty-brown on the undersides.
- **Flower:** A heavy bloomer, white flowers appear early and again late in summer.
