## ***Magnolia stellata* 'Royal Star'**

- **Use:** A fragrant first breath of spring! Popular for early blooming, Royal Star Magnolia produces silky pale pink buds that burst into magnificent double 3-5" white stars. Cut branches are great in arrangements. Trouble-free Japanese native. Enjoy this one-of-a-kind beauty!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun, but tolerates part sun, and tolerates just about any well-drained garden soil.
- **Growth:** Grows 8-20' tall. Space 10-15' apart.
- **Hardiness:** 4-9; Tree.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Elongate leaves.
- **Flower:** Scads of large mildly fragrant snowy-white double-flowers from mid-March through April before its leaves emerge.
