

# Loring Peach Tree



## *Prunus persica* 'Loring'

- **Use:** Loring is an excellent peach for processing, fresh market, canning, and preserves. It is a medium size, round freestone peach with red blush on a yellow background. The fruit hangs well to the tree and holds up well after picking. The trees are a self-fruitful tree that is sturdy, vigorous, and heavy croppers. It is a very reliable producer. Ripens late July to early August and requires 750 chilling hours.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to part sun. Soil should be well-drained. Acidic soil is preferred, though it can tolerate a wide variety of soils. They are not drought-tolerant, so proper watering is a must.
- **Growth:** Grows 10-15' tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7-8; Tree
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Dark green leaves.
- **Flower:** produces beautiful pink blooms in spring and medium-to-large peaches in mid-August (Self-pollinating)
