- **Use:** Loves heat and full sun! Attracts hummingbirds. Blooms nonstop all summer until frost. If you plant them in the ground be sure to plant them with the pot. They like to be pot bound and this way you can bring them into the garage to over-winter.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun (but must be 5-6 hours of after-noon sun) . Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow re-lease fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Loves to be keep moist, but don't leave pot standing in water. Prefers to be root bound so if you plant in the ground be sure to plant them pot and all in the ground so you can easily bring it inside for the winter.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing to bushy to 4 feet in one season. Larger over time.
- **Hardiness:** 8-11; Annual, **Must bring inside in the winter.**
- **Foliage:** Evergreen if brought indoors in winter
- **Flower:** Large trumpets. Blooms April– October nonstop!
