

Star Jasmine



The most wonderful smell for your garden or in a sunny home!

Jasminum illicifolium

- **Use:** A fragrant, tropical that can also be grown as a twining vine. When planted alone, the plant maintains a shrubby form, and wayward growths can be clipped off to keep it in shape. When planted near taller plants or some other type of support, the growth becomes more vine-like, twining around the support and climbing upward.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial sun. Use slow release or water soluble fertilizer. Keep soil moist watering under leaves and flowers for best results. Adding a potting soil with peat moss will really help keep them watered correctly.
- **Growth:** The natural height in shrub form is about 3-4 feet, but as a vine can climb to 15 feet or more.
- **Hardiness: Zone** 9a-11 Tropical, Houseplant; Bring inside in the winter to a sunny windowsill.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Pinch back tips occasionally for a super bushy plant.
- **Flower:** Sweetly fragrant clusters of 2", star-like, pure white blooms are produced continuously throughout the summer months against a rich glossy green foliage.
