

# Giant Pink Mandevilla Trellis



Great to train on your mailbox or to put in a planter near the pool.



## *Mandevilla x 'Giant Pink'*

- **Use:** Large, pale pink blooms appear on this twining vine from early summer through first frost. Glossy, large, deep green foliage is resistant to humidity, pests and disease. Extended bloom makes this a great choice for arbors and trellises around your deck and patio. Blooms appear throughout the summer. So easy to grow! They will tolerate the hottest sun and humidity! Attracts lots of hummingbirds. Great to climb up your mailbox.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Prefers to be root bound so if you plant in the ground be sure to plant them pot and all in the ground so you can easily bring it inside for the winter.
- **Growth:** Moderate grower with stems reaching 6 to 8 ft. long.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual, Must bring inside in the winter.
- **Foliage:** Long oval leaves. Evergreen if brought indoors in winter
- **Flower:** Giant pink trumpets bloom April– October nonstop!
