It is also used in shade landscapes, patio displays, an enjoying view when used in hanging basket, and a stunning container plant.

Neprolepis exaltata 'Dallasii Ramet cv' 'Dallas Jewel'

- **Use:** Outstanding Boston-type fern. A perfect house plant that doesn't shed leaflets or lose color when brought into dimmer light conditions. It will perform well as a good low maintenance interior-landscape plant as well. Its fronds are shorter and grow in different planes to give it a ruffled appearance. The size of the frond is determined by the pot size so Dallas does not overgrow its pot.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers part shade. Grows quickly with dense fronds. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Ferns love humidity. Just be sure to water in the mornings if possible. Water under the leaves as they hate being watered in the center of the plant.
- **Growth:** Mature size of 12-18" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11, Annual, houseplant
- **Foliage:** Pinnae (leaflets) that are wavy and full with shorter fronds to give it a more compact presentation.
- **Flower:** No flowers.
