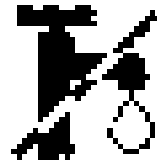


H.F. Young Clematis



Clematis 'H.F. Young'

- **Use:** "Queen of the climbers." Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. For beautiful colors, extravagance of blooms, and graceful habit, nothing compares with Clematis, the queen of the flowering vines. Whether used on posts or fences, clambering through shrubs and trees, or following wire frames in borders, they will enrich the landscape.

Exposure/Soil: Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3" of soil is dry. Prefers to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water. Give them good soil, reasonable moisture, and shade at their roots.

- **Growth:** Fast grower to 8 feet long, but still compact enough to be grown in a container. Prune Group 2 - Prune lightly above the new leaf buds in early spring and remove any dead or weak stems. Early flowers appear on the previous season's growth while late summer flowers appear on new growth.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Delicate green foliage grows quickly.
- **Flowers:** These large flowers are pale blue, a much-beloved color in the garden. In addition, its classically round disc-shaped flowers feature striking blond centers and pointed overlapping sepals, making this a photogenic plant a favorite with collectors. H F Young's medium-sized vine adapts well to containers and is known for a long bloom span if spent flowers are deadheaded along the way. Blooms spring and Autumn.
