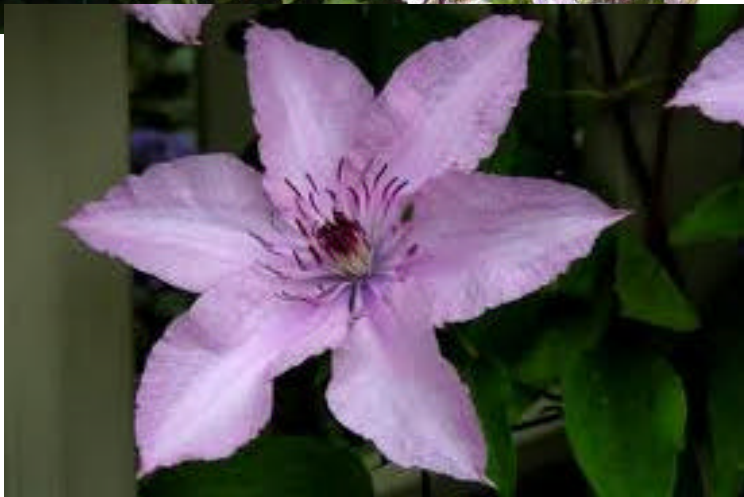
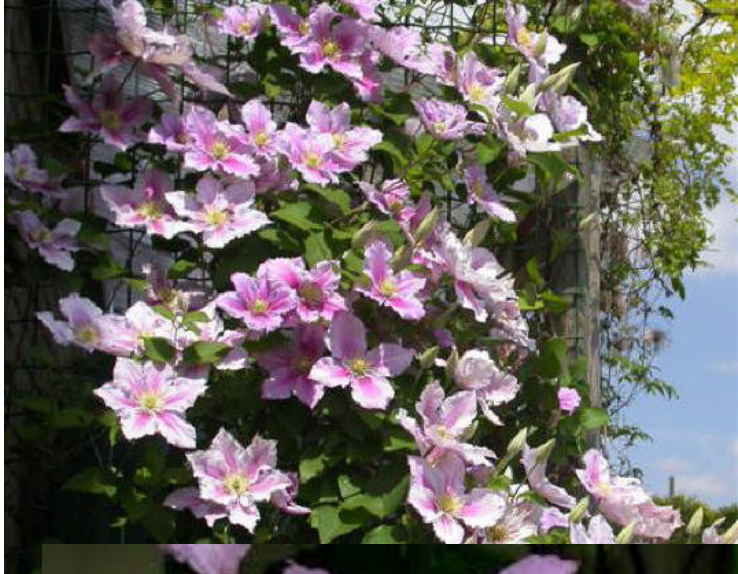


# Clematis Hagley Hybrid



## ***Clematis 'Hagley Hybrid' (Pink Chiffon)***

- **Use:** “Queen of the climbers.” Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. Only needs to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. Stunning when used alone or when several colors are mixed. Also can be used in containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3” of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 8 to 12 feet long.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Often blooms better when pruned in early spring before new growth appears. .
- **Flowers:** Also known as 'Pink Chiffon,' this classic garden climber bears a profusion of rosy-pink flowers with pointed tips and deep-red anthers in summer. A free-flowering and hardy variety of clematis, this specimen works well planted in the border, grown over a shrub, or trained over a trellis or pergola.

**Tough vine that bursts forth with showy flowers from delicate foliage!**
