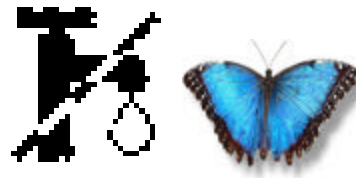


Clematis Miss Bateman



Tough vine that bursts forth with showy flowers from delicate foliage! Left to scramble through a border, they will flower at the feet of annuals and perennials. Trained over a shrub, the blooms will highlight their neighbor's form.



Clematis 'Miss Bateman'

- **Use:** “Queen of the climbers.” Clematis are prized for their incredible flowers, most as large as your hand. Will train onto trellises, fences, or arch over doorways. Only needs to have its roots shaded and its flowers in the sun. Stunning when used alone or when several colors are mixed. Also can be used in containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full sun–shade (not deep shade); Water regularly, when top 3” of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer twice a year. Once established needs only occasional water.
- **Growth:** Fast grower to 8 to 12 feet long.
- **Hardiness:** 3-9; Perennial, Vine
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Often blooms better when pruned in early spring before new growth appears. .
- **Flowers:** Bears large, pure-white flowers with red stamens in early summer.
