

Butterscotch Carolina Jessamine



Gelsemium sempervirens 'Butterscotch'

- **Use:** Prized for its spectacular display of fragrant, bright yellow flowers. Great on trellis, arbor or over fences and walls. Also used as a mounding ground cover.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full to partial sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Vigorous grower to 20 ft. long with support.
- **Hardiness:** 6-9 Vine
- **Foliage:** Evergreen to semi-evergreen.
- **Flower:** Its yellow, sweetly fragrant, funnel-shaped, buttery-yellow blooms appear from very early to mid-spring and may bloom again sporadically in summer and fall.
