

French Pink Hardy Jasmine



Jasminum stephanense

- **Use:** A deliciously scented jasmine, the delicate fragrance intensifying in a warm, sheltered position in sun to partial shade. Hummingbirds visit the shell-pink flowers as soon as they open from furled rose pink buds. A great low maintenance twining vine that blooms early summer and grows easily in a large pot.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant it somewhere sunny, warm and sheltered to best enjoy the scent of the flowers. It will cope with partial shade as long as the soil is well-drained.
- **Growth:** Strong-growing to 10-15 ft and 4' wide. It's a strong-growing deciduous climber that will quickly cover a south or west facing fence or wall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 7b-11, Tender Perennial Vine . Do not cut back stems until April following 1st year. 10 degrees hardiness.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous.
- **Flower:** Loose cymes bear deep pink buds and long, flared tubular light pink blooms surrounded by slender angular green shoots and small, ovate-shaped matte-green leaves, which are often edged in creamy yellow.
