

Gold Flame Honeysuckle



Lonicera heckrottii 'Gold Flame'



- **Use:** This sprawling grower has vine-like stems displaying green leaves tinted purple underneath. Goldflame Honeysuckle is a hybrid of unclear origin; possibly *sempervirens* x *americana*. It is a handsome vine with beautiful red buds that open to expose yellow petals. Will continue to bloom from late spring through the summer as it grows.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing vine to 10 to 15 ft. long. Can also be pruned back to form a dense shrub 4 to 6 feet round.
- **Hardiness:** 5-9, Perennial Vine or shrub
- **Foliage:** Semideciduous.
- **Flower:** Flowers 5 or more months a year.
