

Honey Baby Honeysuckle



After ten years of trials by plant breeders and scientists in Boskoop, Holland, the very specific criteria of creating a compact growing shrub instead of the usual vine form was met. Honey Baby® is excellent plant for balcony and terrace.



Lonicera sempervirens 'Honey Baby'

- **Use:** Cultivated in private gardens and in cities as an ornamental because of its large, fragrant flowers and brilliant red fruits. Large creamy-yellow fragrant flowers. Prune and tie stems in early spring. Remove all dead and weak stems, and trim the remaining stems 5-8 inches to where a strong pair of leaf buds appear. Remaining stems should be tied in a position that gives sufficient space for new growth.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Prefers full sun to part sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry to start. Little water needed once established.
- **Growth:** Fast-growing vine to 6-7' tall. Can also be pruned back to form a dense shrub 4 to 6 feet round.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial Vine or Shrub
- **Foliage:** Semi-deciduous. Bluish green foliage.
- **Flower:** Flowers abundantly grow in racemes together, first, buds appear purplish red, opening to colors of soft cream, light yellow and then to lemon yellow, while emitting a delightful perfume. Red berries appear in the Fall. Sterile/ non-invasive. Blooms July thru October. Attracts hummingbirds.
