Thunbergia alata 'Arizona Rose Sensation'

- **Use:** Whimsical pink petals with dark centers and an old-fashioned beauty spiral upward for a sweet profusion of color! Early flowering, vigorous vines climb a trellis or trail from hanging baskets. The lush, green foliage and bountiful 1" blossoms will complete the corners of a sunny patio. Managing to look very bushy but never getting out of hand, this vine is ideal for growing up through fences and gates, pillars and poles. Especially effective in containers, where its very full habit looks incredibly lush!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full– part sun or at least 5-6 hours of afternoon sun. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. In hot summer needs lots of water.
- **Growth:** Grows 4-6 feet tall and continues to vine. May cut back if desired.
- **Hardiness:** 9-11, annual, houseplant. Protect from temperatures below 40 degrees. Save seeds to plant them again each year.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous as annual; Evergreen as houseplant
- **Flower:** Another fantastic hue of vigorous climbing vine, thunbergia! The rose pink flowers bloom all summer.
