

# Kanga® Series Kangaroo Paw

**Named for its velvety, bright-flowers that resemble the paws of our favorite marsupial, it originates from west Australia.**

## ***Anigozanthos 'Kanga Series'***

- **Use:** This tough, durable, drought resistant plant provides vibrant color with clusters of unique, velvety, tubular, bright flowers on slender, fuzzy stalks emerging from clumps of upright, sword-like, green leaves. Great for adding color and texture to annual borders, in containers, or indoors as a houseplant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun, but will tolerate some shade. Also does well near a south-facing wall or near a high canopy with bright shade. Prefers well-drained, sandy soils and good drainage (raised beds are ideal.) Good air circulation is important and protect from extensive rains.
- **Growth:** Reaches 12 to 14 in. tall; blooms reach 20 to 24 in. tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 9-11; Annual Cold hardy to 25-30° F, Bring indoors in winter and enjoy as a houseplant, but water sparingly at 2-3 times per month indoors.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Narrow green foliage.
- **Flower:** Stalks of velvety, bright flowers appear from spring until fall. An excellent, long-lasting cut flower. A favorite of hummingbirds.
