

Harmony's Fire Woman Begonia



Use in patio containers, hanging baskets, beds, or as a house-plant.

Begonia 'Harmony's Fire Woman'

- **Use:** A gorgeous houseplant or for use in mixed planters on a shady porch in the warmer months. A compact, bushy grower with soft pink flowers. An heirloom cane-type begonia.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Performs well in part sun to shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Good drainage is a must. Likes high humidity.
- **Growth:** Grows 16-24" tall and 16-20" wide, maybe taller if deep shade or rich soil. Pinching tips and pruning outer stems in the growing season gives a bushier plant, good for hanging baskets.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 10-11, annual, houseplant. Bring inside in winter.
- **Foliage:** The striking pink banding over white with a dark center and veins is evident year round.
- **Flower:** White-pink clusters of blossoms on and off throughout the year.
