Begonia x semperflorens-cultorum 'Nightlife Series'

- <u>Use:</u> Very versatile and can be used in baskets, containers, garden beds, or in large landscape plantings. Landscapers love to plant the red begonias with Chartreuse Joseph coat for a brilliant contrast as in the photo to the left.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Sun-shade. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry. Use slow release fertilizer for best results. Brown leaf variety will tolerate more sun if the soil is not fantastic. Keep water off leaves and flowers.
- <u>Growth</u>: Grows 6-8" tall and 8-10" wide, maybe taller if deep shade or rich soil.
- *Hardiness: Zone* 9-11, Annual, Houseplant
- Foliage: We find the brown leaves to be more sun tolerant than the green leaved types.
- <u>Flower:</u> A multitude of blossoms from spring to fall make this one
 of the landscape plants for high impact color! Many colors to
 choose from.
